	No apologies had been received.	
NP107	MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING	
	The minutes of the meeting held on 31 st August were agreed as a correct record and duly signed.	
NP108	PRE-SUBMISSION CONSULTATION	
	The pre-submission consultation period had ended and the comments from residents and developers collated. ClIrs Simons and Conolly and the Clerk had met with AVDC that morning to clarify some points and the NP would be updated accordingly.	
	Developers had queried the 400m distance to a bus stop for new developments and suggested that it should be 800m or greater. The 400m limit had been taken from DFT Guidance "Inclusive Mobility" and after discussion it was agreed to leave the limit at 400m.	
	The updated neighbourhood plan would be circulated to the steering group for final comment along with the consultation responses. All steering group members were asked to read both documents and send any amendments to the Clerk.	
	Local green spaces designation was discussed. It was agreed to take out the recreation ground as the designation would prevent additional facilities being added to the site and that the Parish Council would seek to protect the site by other means.	
	The owners of green spaces in the centre of the village had confirmed they were happy with their land being designated as green space. Two further landowners were to be written to who own land in this area.	
	One landowner had objected to their land being designated and upon advice from AVDC, it was agreed to invite them to meet with councillors to discuss their concerns.
