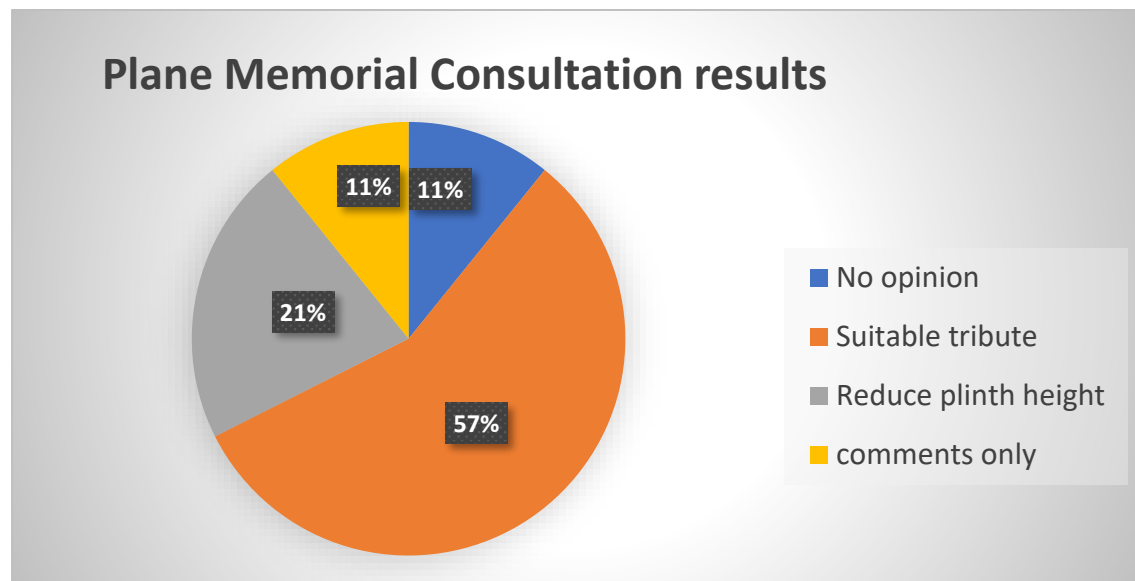


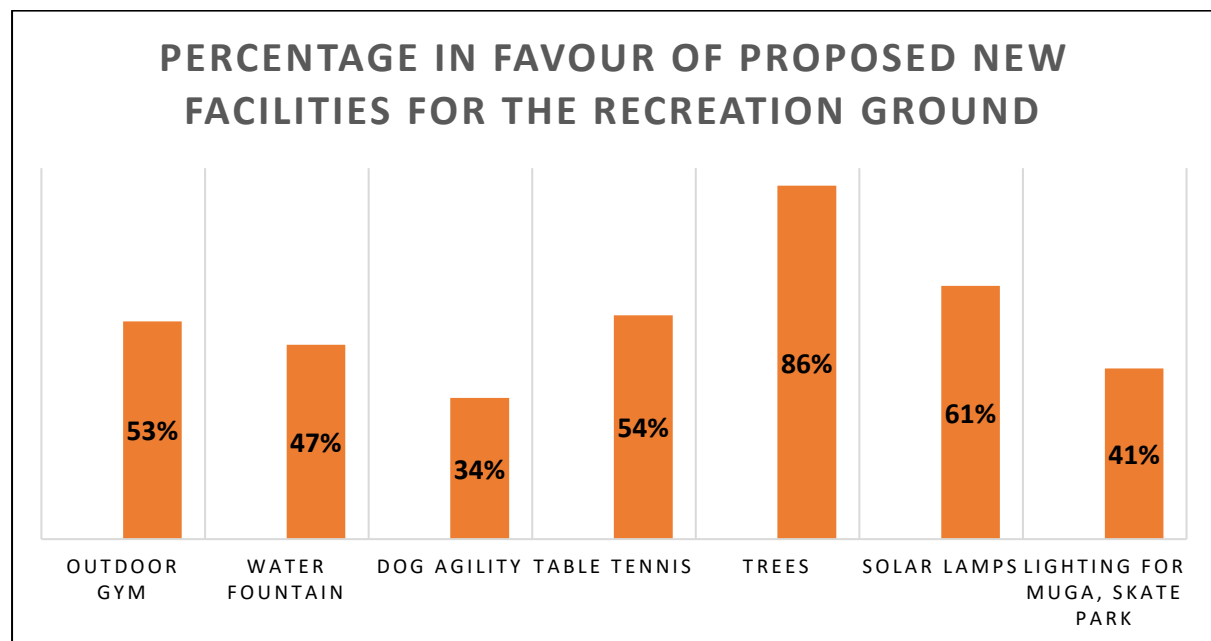
Consultation Responses

2 - Facilities at the Recreation Ground

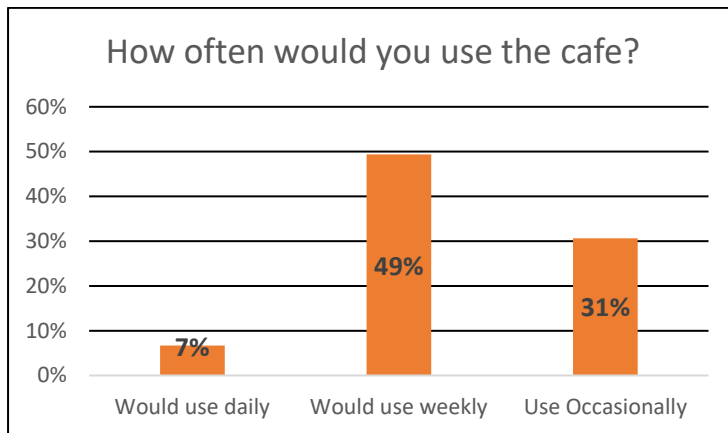


Other suggestions:

Church Lane / Worlds End Lane junction

Bates Lane / Main Street junction

Outside shops

By new café

Outside bungalows in School Lane

Junction of New Road and Brook End (where the tree fell down)

Designate existing benches
